

Cookies Policy

Introduction and scope

To make this website work properly, and to provide the most relevant services to our site visitors, we place small data files called cookies on your device. This statement provides you with information about cookies and how to control them for this website.

This document is an integral and substantial part of the <https://www.systemicmastocytosis-hcp.com/privacy-policy> and the information contained therein complies with the provisions set out by applicable data protection and data privacy laws and regulations, as amended and in force. What is a cookie

A cookie is a small file, typically consisting of letters and numbers, downloaded onto a device when the visitor accesses a website. Cookies are then sent back to the originating website on each subsequent visit. Cookies are useful because they improve the website's functionality and overall performance and provide the visitor with a more personalized experience. They also help us to understand how visitors are using our website and the services provided therein.

For some time, the use of cookies and similar technologies has been commonplace. Cookies are particularly important in the provision of many online services. Using such technologies is not, therefore, prohibited by the law, but they do require that people are well informed in advance about the use of cookies installed on a website and are given the choice to directly accept all cookies, or if they wish, to customize their cookies preferences.

Cookies that we use

There are two broad categories of cookies: First-party cookies (served directly by us to your device) and third-party cookies (served by a third party, e.g., Google).



Cookies can remain on your computer or mobile device for different periods of time. Some cookies are “session cookies,” meaning that they exist only while your browser is open. These are deleted automatically once you close your browser. Other cookies are “persistent cookies,” meaning that they are saved after your browser is closed. When you open your browser and browse the internet again, persistent cookies can be used by the website to recognize your computer.

Google Analytics

Log Files
